Krakow was the capital of Poland and the seat of kings until 1596. Your morning sightseeing includes the town square - the largest in Europe and its medieval centre. It emerged relatively unscathed from WWII. After lunch, drive to Auschwitz to visit the Martyrdom Museum of the former Nazi concentration camp. Overnight Krakow. **BL**

Day 6 Thu. Krakow

Morning free. In the afternoon, visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine with its lakes, underground chambers, grottoes and chapels carved from salt by generations of Polish miners over 700 years. Enjoy dinner with a folklore performance at a local restaurant. Overnight Krakow. **BD**

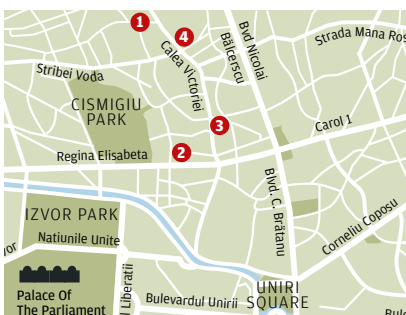

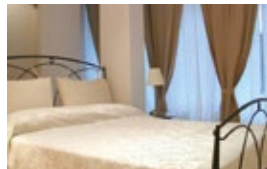

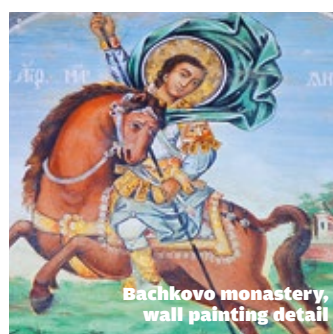
