# Frequently asked questions



### What is the earliest time I can check-in for my train departure?

The earliest time you may check-in for your rail service is approximately 2 hours prior to the train's scheduled departure time (times may vary, please call 13 21 47 for further details). Please note that Great Southern Rail ask all guests to check-in at least 1 hour prior to departure.

#### Can I fly out the same day as the train arrives?

We highly recommend that guests allow for at least 3-5 hours after the scheduled arrival time of a train, or preferably an overnight stopover (especially for international flights) before a plane flight. Unfortunately, trains can sometimes be delayed and run behind

### What medical assistance is provided by train staff?

Great Southern Rail staff members are trained to administer basic first aid; however staff members are not able to provide assistance with ongoing medical conditions during a journey. Guests requiring medical attention or mobility assistance onboard any of our trains are required to arrange for their own carer to travel with them.

#### Can my necessary medication be refrigerated?

Yes, subject to space within our onboard fridge compartments. Please inform us of any medication requirements at the time of booking.

#### Can I take oxygen onboard?

Yes, please inform us of any oxygen requirements at the time of booking.

### Is there any EFTPOS/Credit Card facilities onboard the train?

You are able to purchase meals, snacks and beverages using a credit card onboard; however, there are no EFTPOS or cash out facilities available onboard our trains.

### What is the standard of dress whilst onboard the train?

Smart casual attire is suggested for guests travelling in Platinum and Gold Service. Neat casual attire is required in Red Service. Warm clothes are recommended for evenings onboard the train, as the air-conditioning can be cool. It is recommended that guests pack a hat, sunscreen and comfortable walking shoes for off-train touring. Sensible shoes are advisable for walking between carriages.

#### Can I take any pets or animals onboard?

No, the only animals permitted on Great Southern Rail train services are specially trained dogs for the vision and hearing impaired.

#### As an overseas visitor to Australia, do I qualify for the pension concession fare if I am a pensioner or senior citizen back home?

As part of our agreement with the Australian Government, we must secure an eligible Australian Pension Concession Card number at the time of booking. This agreement with the Australian Federal Government does not extend to pensioners from overseas countries. It is strictly limited to Australian pensioners who are residents of Australia.

### Can I take my walking frame/wheelchair/scooter onboard the train?

No, these items must be checked in as stored luggage. A specially modified wheelchair can be requested for use onboard the train (with the assistance of a carer or travelling companion). Please inform us at the time of booking if you require a wheelchair.

### What are the parking arrangements at the railway station?

Parking facilities at all Great Southern Rail stations and terminals are provided on a short-term basis only. It is not possible to park you vehicle in the car parks of our stations and terminals for extended periods due to safety concerns.

#### Can I store my luggage at the railway station?

For bookings made at 45 days or less prior to travel, full payment will be required at the time of booking.

Great Southern Rail reserves the right to charge an additional fee for transactions paid by credit card.

Different booking and payment conditions may apply to special offers. These will be advised at the time of booking.

Great Southern Rail Travel Pty Ltd reserves the right to accept waitlist bookings if you fail to comply with these payment

Different booking and payment conditions may apply to accommodation or tours. These will be advised at the time of booking.

Where a booking is on request through a third party supplier, cancellation and amendment fees will not apply if that booking cannot be confirmed.

An on request booking will not be accepted until confirmed by the third party supplier.

#### **Concession Fares**

Pensioners, Commonwealth Seniors Health Card holders and Children must meet the following respective criteria to be eligible for Concession Fares:

Pensioner Fares: Must hold a valid Australian PCC Card

Australian Commonwealth Seniors Health Card Holder: Must hold a valid card.

To receive concessional travel fares, Great Southern Rail is required to confirm your eligibility for the concession electronically with Centrelink. If you do not want this to happen you will need to contact Centrelink or the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) to obtain a Pension Concession Letter as proof of your eligibility for the concession and provide this directly to Great Southern Rail before the concession can be given.

Pensioner and Commonwealth Seniors Health Card Holders may be entitled to Concession Fares that are partly or fully funded by the Commonwealth or State governments. To qualify for Concession Fares, Australian Pensioner or Commonwealth Seniors Health Cards must be presented at the time of booking, must be valid at the time of travel and must be carried at all times during travel. Not all sectors are included in arrangements for the funding of concessions. 

May take hand luggage including garment bag, cabin bag, briefcase.

#### $Red\ Service-Day/Nighter\ Seat:$

May take cabin bag.

Due to cabin space constraints, it is recommended Gold and Red Service guests take an 'overnight bag' containing the requirements for their journey with them and check in all their luggage. Please note, checked in luggage cannot be accessed during the journey.

#### Luggage: Hotel, Touring, Coach and Air Travel

Guests must abide by the following luggage limitations depending on the transport options to be utilised in their holiday packages:

Coach and Air Travel: Each guest is entitled to take one case. The sum of the case's length, width and depth must not exceed 140cm (54 inches), and a weight limit of 23 kilograms applies subject to the individual transport operator.
