**Patmos** - See the 11<sup>th</sup> century Monastery of St. John which today stands imposingly on top of the hill of Hora and was built to protect the people of Patmos from pirates and other invaders. St. John's exiled home on the island - The Holy Grotto - is a further must-see highlight.

**Rhodes** - Ramble through the medieval Old Town of Rhodes and visit the picturesque town of Lindos, home to the ruins of the Acropolis and 15<sup>th</sup> century Captain's Houses.

**Santorini** - Tour the volcanic island of Santorini with his spectacular cliff-top villages and the crescent-shaped caldera which has created a natural bay. Walk through the charming town of Oia for the best sunsets in Greece and explore the beautiful traditional countryside.

**Knossos** - A tribute to some of Greece's most magnificent myths and legends, and home to the mythical King Minos, the ancient city of Knossos has been home to the Minoans since 1900 BC and remnants of their civilisation including the Palace of Knossos can still be seen today.

**Kusadasi, Ephesus** - Visit the ancient Greek city of Ephesus, which remained largely untouched until the 19<sup>th</sup> century - its Temple of Artemis, one of the World's Seven Ancient Wonders, Temple of Hadrian and terraced houses are must-see open-air antiquities to explore.

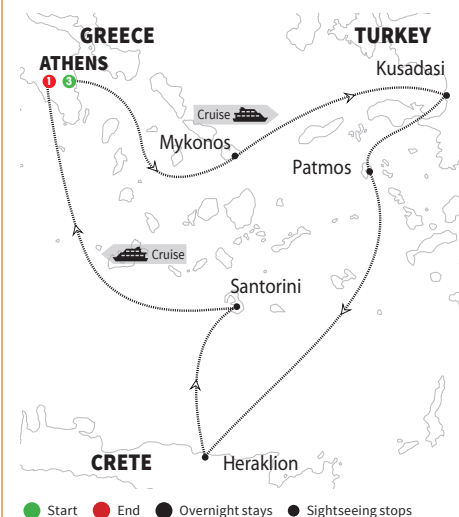

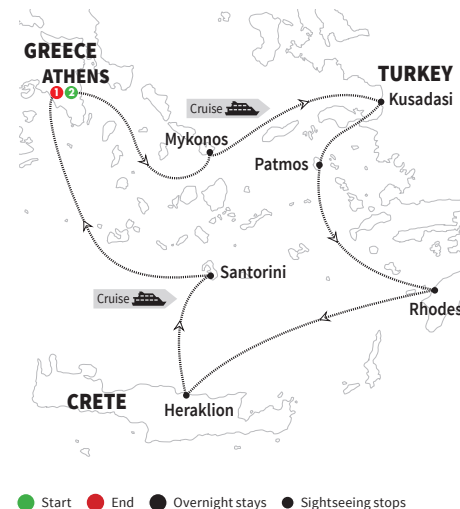

Enjoy an included visit to the Acropolis Museum containing remarkable antiquities. See Hadrian's Arch, built to celebrate the arrival of the Roman Emperor Hadrian, and the stadium where the first modern Olympics took place in 1896. Spend the rest of the day as you wish. 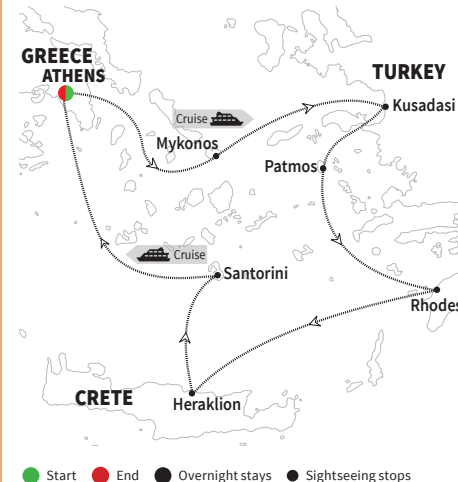

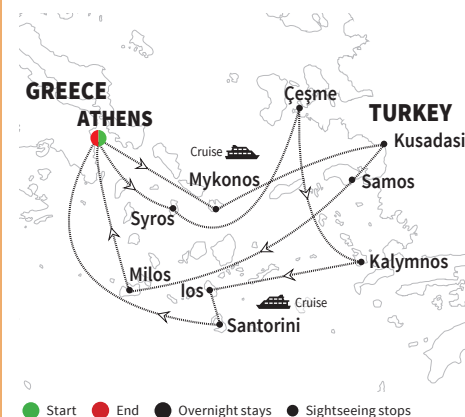
