# Top 5 Drives

We love the USA as a self-drive holiday destination! Experience everything of this vast landscape from desert to high alpine regions. Whether you're looking for culture, music or just want to explore the outdoors, summer or winter, we'd like to take you on a tour of some of our favourite drives!



#### **Pacific Coast Highway, California**

If you're heading to California, consider taking one of the most scenic drives, Los Angeles to San Francisco. Heading north west out of LA, Highway 1 (or the Pacific Coast Scenic Highway as it's referred to at stages of the route), will take you along the beachfront of Santa Monica and through the decadent hills of Malibu Beach. Head up through Ventura County and stop at Santa Barbara. As you continue along the highway, look out for sea lion colonies and wildlife along the coast.

At picturesque Morrow Bay, once an abalone fishing port, stop off at Morro Rock – a volcanic plug. The highway takes you into the stunning coastal region of Big Sur, where the Santa Lucia Mountains abruptly meet the Pacific Ocean. The region is renowned for its giant Redwood forests and coastal views, stretching for around 140km. Travel across the impressive Bixby Creek Bridge, which opened in 1932 to connect the residents in winter and is one of the tallest spanning bridges in the world.

The highway then continues along the coastline of Monterey Bay, through Sand City, Seaside and Marina. A popular stop for families, Monterey Bay Aquarium is renowned for its Ocean Sunfish, along with stingrays, jelly fish and sea otters. The waterfront street of Cannery Row is a great place to dine with its many restaurants and where the offshore area is home to one of the largest Californian Sea Lion colonies.

Head further north west onto Santa Cruz and into San Francisco. There is so much to see and do in this vibrant city, but a must is to drive over the Golden Gate Bridge and visit Alcatraz. Stop off for a few days and explore the shopping, take a tram ride, dine at Fisherman's Wharf and drive the eight hairpin bends of Lombard Street!



#### Going to the Sun Road

Situated at the very top of the USA, this is one of the most breathtaking drives in North America and home to untouched scenery and wildlife. Discover all types of landscapes from windswept tundra, to cedar forests, incredible glacial lakes, and breathtaking mountains. Major highlights include the Jackson Glacier, the 'weeping wall', and the high point (literally) is Logan's Pass where you can hike up to the hidden lake look-out. Going to the Sun Road is only accessible from June to mid-late October depending on the snow-fall.



#### Route 66

One of the longest attractions in the USA, Route 66 stretches from Chicago to Los Angeles. Although it's impossible to drive in its entirety nowadays, you can still explore parts of the highway that people describe as 'the real America'. From old abandoned gas stations, the infamous Cadillac Ranch, the historic train station in Flagstaff, and the 9 Route 66 museums, there's plenty to see and do. Stop off at one of the many iconic 66 roadside diners like Dell Ray's Chicken Basket or Cozy Dog Drive for a true taste of Americana!




#### The Seward Highway

Linking Anchorage with Seward it passes through some of the most spectacular scenery in Arctic United States. There are no billboards, no tollbooths, few towns, and even fewer gas stations. You can race through the drive in under three hours, however it is best to devote at least a weekend to this natural tranquillity and explore some of the most appealing sights in south-central Alaska. If you're looking for whales and waterfalls, blue glaciers and sharp-toothed mountains, calm trout ponds and stormy ocean creeks, there's enough visual here to fill a hard drive with breathtaking pictures.



#### **The Hawaiian Belt**

Circling Hawaii's Big Island, the Hawaiian Belt offers a variety of landscapes such as lava flows, exotic beaches, green highlands, breathtaking mountains and plunging valleys. Immerse yourself in the Polynesian heritage and culture that landed here thousands of years ago. The best way to travel around The Belt is by car, exploring the coffee plantations of Kana, Captain Cook's memorial and of course the active lava fields of the Hawaiian Volcano National Park.







# Top 5 Drives

Canada combines breathtaking landscapes, precious wildlife and friendly people unlike any other country. Whether you are travelling west, east, north or south, you can never get enough of Canada.




#### **Icefield Parkway**

Hit the road to find out why National Geographic named Highway 93, otherwise known as Icefield Parkway, one of the top 20 "drives of a lifetime". Located in the Canadian province of Alberta, the "Promenade des Glaciers", was completed in 1940 and includes a variety of accommodation options for any budget. Take note, this aesthetic path becomes quite popular during the Canadian summer months of July and August.

Before you start, buy a park pass at the entrance to Jasper National Park. You'll need this to drive the Parkway. The first stop on your journey is the town of Jasper, itself a UNESCO World Heritage site. Jasper offers Canada's longest aerial tramway, sure to provide breathtaking views, as well as the Miette Hot Spring, boasting the title of hottest spring in the Canadian Rockies at a steamy 54°C. Travel south to the Columbia Icefield, most of which runs along the Athabasca Glacier.

Stop over to ride an Ice Explorer to the top and walk along a crystal clear, 10,000 year old piece of ice, as thick as the Eiffel Tower is tall. Thirsty? Drink straight from the stream to taste the freshest water in the world as it ebbs out to three different oceans. The next stop is Peyto Lake, the highest point of your journey. For a quick visit, hike a 10 minute paved trail to the Peyto Lake viewpoint. If you have more time, follow the old fire road for phenomenal views from the Bow Summit lookout. Make sure to wear comfy shoes and pack a snack, as this route takes about 2.5 hours round trip.

Icefield Parkway ends on a high note at Lake Louise, the first national park in Canada. Marvel at this stunning, glacierfed body of water and watch artists create magical ice sculptures. There is no shortage of entertainment at Lake Louise; enjoy paddling in the water in the summer months or ice skating in the winter.





The drive from Toronto to Niagara Falls is approximately 132km and will take around two hours. From Toronto, take the Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) towards Hamilton and St. Catharine's through to Highway 402. Visitors departing from other destinations in Southwest Ontario may also travel on Highway 20, leading directly to the falls, or on Highway 3, which takes you along several small roads, straight into the city. Once you reach Niagara Falls, you will find something for everyone. Not only can you experience the spectacular falls, but there is also a range of activities to make Niagara Falls a world class destination.

#### **Dempster Highway**

Experience a world apart on the Dempster Highway, the most northerly road in Canada. The route leads travellers through Yukon and the Northwest Territories. Take in the magical power of Aurora Borealis, the Northern Lights, visible here up to 240 nights of the year. Start in historic Dawson City, seemingly stuck in the Klondike Gold Rush of the late 1800s. Your destination is the Mackenzie Delta town of Inuvik, the largest settlement north of the Arctic Circle. Ferries carry cars across the river during North American summer (June-August) and vehicles can drive right over the ice in winter (December-February), but the passage may be closed in spring and autumn.



#### Sea to Sky Highway

Ranked as one of the top five road trips in the world, Highway 99 from Vancouver to Whistler is sure to be a memorable journey. The Sea to Sky Highway is a 135km journey along a backdrop of glistening waters and famous scenic landmarks. There is the island of Howe Sound, Shannon Falls and the snow-capped Coast Mountains. If you're looking for something to do along the way, be sure to check out the old mining town of Britannia Beach, which has a mining museum and several arts and crafts stores. To reach Highway 99, head north from Vancouver for 30 minutes.



#### **Golden Circle**

Make sure you have at least 6 days to venture around the Golden Circle. At 600km long, it begins and ends in the town of Whitehorse, located in the north western province of Yukon. Head south to Skagway in Alaska, a gold mining town that also seems to have been frozen in time. Drive back north into Canada and explore Kluane National Park and Reserve, a World Heritage Site at Haines Junction. It is recommended to spend two nights here in order to have a full day to enjoy the park's exceptional scenery and range of activities. When you're ready to return, head back to Whitehorse.




